Dear Judge Manuel L. Real;

Here is my lawsuit placed on 28 lined paper. I have also included here the Proof of Service for notifying the other parties. Here is also both my California & Federal tax returns for 2001 & 2002, sent out on 12/3/08, just to prove the FRAUD committed by the FTB and IRS after both have sent out a 'Withholding Order' and Notice of Levy.' Swift Transportation now has become involved in criminal activity with the FTB and the IRS by handing over wages based on fraudulent assessments. The IRS did respond to my sending in my 2002 return as included here their letter from Cincinnati, OH. Yet it has been twice, at more than a year, for the IRS to respond for any decision on my 1997, 1998, and 1999 amended returns.
